

Statement of Evidence:

- 1918 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 6" Cedar N 47-30 W 44 links and 5" Poplar S 12 W 22 links.
- 1980 USFS technician Gary Brama found the GLO marked brass cap up 6" and one GLO bearing tree 18"-Balm of Gilead S 12° W 14.52'. No evidence of the cedar was found. New bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts were set east and south of the corner.
- 1981 On Dec. 8, I visited corner and found items as per 1980 USFS report. Balm of Gilead has overgrown scar.
- 1981 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
