

In 1917, Earl G. Harrington a US surveyor set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for the CN 1/16 corner from which he made the following BT's. A 8" red oak N 12 E 69 LKS and a 8" red oak N 87 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 190 LKS.

On October 8, 1981, Walter E. Curo and Paul Johnson find the brass cap monument standing in good condition. A old 12" red oak bears N 12 E 45' as it is lying down, We can't find any marks on it. There is no trace of the other BT. We make new BT's as shown on front.
