


CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

In 1917, Earl G. Harrington, a US Surveyor set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for AP 1 TR 1711 and AP 3 TR 1286 and AP 4 TR 1703. No BT's were made.

On September 17, 1981, Walter E. Curo and Paul Johnson find the brass cap monument bent over. We remove it and try to straighten it, but it breaks, so we replace it with a 2"x60" iron pipe with brass cap from which we made BT's as shown on front.
