

Statement of Evidence:

- 1926 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 10" Spruce N 12 W 24 links and 6" Maple S 46-30 W 29 links.
- 1981 U.S. Forest Service technician G. Brama found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 1". The following bearing trees were found: Badly rotted Spruce stump at N 12 W 15.8'. No evidence found of the Maple at record bearing and distance. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts were set 2.7' north and 3.1' east of the corner. In 1982, G. Brama marked one additional bearing tree and is shown on this certificate.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1926 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
