

Statement of Evidence: North Quarter Corner Section 1, T.134 N., R.32 W., 5th P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 6" Sp.Pine N 69°E 38 lks., 10" Sp.Pine N 41°W 15 lks.
- 1985 On August 28, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician found 1½" I.P. down 0.75', 3.5' S. of E-W centerline, 5.5' W. of fence S.
- 1986 On July 29, Terry Freeman and Dan Gordon left monument as found and marked ties as shown on front of this certificate.

Although there is not a record of the found I.P. being set, the Cass County Surveyors Office accepts it as a perpetuation of the original corner.
