



Statement of Evidence: Center-North one-sixteenth Corner, Section 1, T.141 N., R.28 W.,
5th P.M.

- 1919 US General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner, setting a 1"x36" I.P. with marked brass cap. The following bearing trees were marked: 18" Elm N $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 173 lks., 30" W. Oak S $45\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W 153 lks.
- 1972 US Forest Service personnel searched for corner, but did not find it.
- 1987 Walt Curo, under Forest Service contract, found the US GLO brass cap monument in place. He marked new bearings: 8" Burr Oak N 87° W 27.95', 12" Burr Oak N 38° W 14.93', 8" Burr Oak N 71° E 25.80'
