- 1919 US General Land Office dependent resurvey set a 1"x36" I.P. with marked brass cap for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 5" Red Oak N 51½°E 200 lks., 10" N. Pine S 11¼°E 155 lks.
- 1973 US Forest Service personnel found the brass cap monument tipped over at fence corner and stump of 1919 BT SE. New bearings: 14" N. Pine N 25°E 72.0', 7" N. Pine S 53°E 98.4', 13" N. Pine S 18°W 111.5', all scribed "CE 1/16 S1 BT", 6' steel sign post on N. Side of monument. William Okerman filed CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER.
- 1987 Walt Curo, under Forest Service contract, found GLO brass cap monument in place and marked the following bearing trees: 15" Poplar N 32°E 39.70', 6" Burr Oak S 49°E 35.50', 4" Ash N 71°E 33.40'. He files this certificate to update the 1973 certificate.
