



**Statement of Evidence:**

EAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 138 NORTH,  
RANGE 32 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN

The original Public Land Survey was run by Mahlon Black in 1870. A post was set to mark the corner and two bearing trees were recorded as accessories; a 12- inch Tamarck South 47 degrees East 4 links, and a 10- inch Tamarck South 87 degrees West 6 links.

In 1996 the Minnesota Department of Transportation conducted an intensive search for additional document, physical and parole evidence for this corner. None could be found.

Analysis of the above information indicates that this Public Land Survey corner is lost. May 28, 1997 a Mn/DOT square steel perforated tube with an aluminum cap was placed in lost position to mark this corner; a single proportion measurement between the southeast and northeast corners of Section 4.
