

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

Index No. E - 13

Northeast Corner, Section 9, Township 139 North, Range 26 West, Cass County, Minnesota

- 1863 Johnson and Thorton, Deputy Surveyors, in accordance with contract, established this corner and set a wood post from which the following ties were recorded: A 30 inch White Pine, North 15 degrees East, 47 links (31.02 feet); A 8 inch Black Oak, South 49 degrees East, 48 links (31.68 feet); A 24" White Pine, South 14 degrees West, 29 links (19.14 feet); A 16 inch White Pine, North 38 degrees West, 18 links (11.88 feet).
- 1937 Civilian Conservation Corp (CCC) set 4 inch square Oak Post - see Washburn Lake, Book #7.
- 1989 John Walker, RLS#16098 - Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, files Certificate of Survey with Cass County Surveyor showing County Survey Monument found, with distances and bearings to the East Quarter Corner, Section 9 and the North Quarter Corner, Section 10.
- 1998 Terry L. Freeman, RLS#21367, Landecker & Associates, Inc., finds Monument found by Walker and references same in Section breakdown calculation of Section 3, filed with the Cass County Surveyor's office.
- 2006 David S. Landecker, RLS#17008, Landecker & Associates, Inc. found said County Survey Monument and accepts it to be the perpetuation of the Original Corner and records the following ties: An 8 inch Maple, North 50 degrees East, 33.25 feet; An 8 inch White Oak, South 65 degrees East, 46.00 feet; A 16 inch Maple, South 33 degrees East, 15.42 feet; A 10 inch Maple, South 62 degrees West, 36.17 feet; A Steel Post, West, 1.00 feet.
