West Meander Corner on North Line of Section 27, Township 140 N, Range 29 W



Statement of Evidence: the West meander corner on the North line of Section 27, Township 140 North, Range 29 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1870 the Original Government Survey was run and a post was set to mark the corner. Bearing tree ties were made to a Cedar and a Norway Pine.

In 1970, R.F. Schneider set a 2 inch pipe to mark the corner. Bearing ties were made to a Red Oak and a White Oak.

In 2005, Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a 2" iron pipe monument. Bearing ties were made to a cabin corner, a White Spruce, a Red Oak, and a Spruce tree. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
