NORTHEAST Corner of Section 5, Township 139 N, Range 27 W



STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE**Northeast Corner Section 5, Township 139 North, Range 27 West, 5th P.M.**

1863 The US General Land Office field notes, on file in the Secretary of State's Office, indicate a post set at the corner with the following bearing trees:

15" Y. Pine	N 80° E	70 Links (46.2')
12" Y. Pine	S 65° E	80 Links (52.8')
5" Tamarack	S 45° W	162 Links (106.92')
4" Tamarack	N 11° W	57 Links (37.62')

1873 The US General Land Office field notes, on file in the Secretary of State's Office, indicate a post reestablished for the corner from original bearing trees.

1939 Civilian Conservation Corps field notes, Book 7, page 21, located at Washburn Lake DNR Forestry office indicate a found squared stake at the corner in a small bog.

2008 In September, the DNR survey crew found the bottom 2.5 feet of a post just below the surface of a grass swamp standing vertical. After excavating next to it, the remaining 4.5 feet of the squared post was recovered lying about a foot below the surface with scribing still legible. After further investigation, a charred stump of the northeast GLO bearing tree was found, the stump remains of the southwest GLO bearing tree was found, and the root system of the northwest GLO bearing tree was also found. All three fit very well with the found post. The post was accepted as the corner and replaced by a 1"x 78" inside diameter iron pipe with plastic cap stamped "MN DNR LS 44974" and ties were taken.
