

Statement of Evidence

Nov.16, 1863 - G.A.Johnson, GLO Deputy Surveyor, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows: 10" Y Pine S 73 degrees W 35 links (23.10 feet).

The above record is on file with the Secretary of State, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are on file in the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).

CCSO Files

Apr. 7, 1911, J. Curo, LS 1428, Curo Field Book 74, page 6, & Book A, pages 349-352, on file in the CCSO, States "We find the Pine standing plainly marked from which we set the meander corner".

1941 - CCC personnel, Washburn Lake notes, Emily Game Refuge Book, page 18, on file in the DNR Office, states at 2872' from South – found 14" Y Pine B.T. for MC.

Karvacko Engineering

Oct. 31, 2013 - Karvacko Engineering Survey Crew searched for and verified the location of the pine stump GLO bearing tree which was found by CCSO in 2004. Established MC#5 at N 73 degrees East 23.10 feet from the found stump to MC#5 which fell into Edna Lake. Set a ½ inch outside diameter iron pipe stamped with 17768 for a witness corner to MC#5 at a distance of 13.00 feet south from said MC #5 using a line from the NE-12 passing through MC #5. The following witnesses were marked for the witness corner to MC #5: 6" Red Pine N 7 degrees E 5.33 feet; 14" Red Pine S 80 degrees E 24.26 feet; 14" Red Pine S 83 degrees West 4.79 feet.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicated that the monument set using Obliterated Methods is the accepted location of this corner.
