

Statement of Evidence:

- 1918 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner. and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 4" Birch N 66 E 402 links and 6" N. Pine S 10-45 W 372 links.
- 1965 Corner certificate by William Oberman, RLS #6807, shows GLO brass cap monument found in place in good condition. Two new bearing trees were taken and marked: 10" N. Pine N 5 E 14.7' and 10" N. Pine N 35 W 39.4'. Certificate was filed 6/28/68.
- 1980 USFS technician W. Olson found the GLO monument in place and the two 1965 bearing trees. One new bearing tree was marked and is shown on this certificate. A steel sign post is 6.3' west of the corner.
- 1981 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Corner was visited on Jan. 29 and items found as per 1965 corner certificate and 1980 USFS report, except evidence was found of one 1918 bearing tree: 22" N. Pine S 10⁰ W 245.5' with old double blaze scars. I accepted monument found as being in same position as set in 1918.
