

Statement of Evidence: Northeast Corner Section 7, Township 138 North,
Range 30 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

In 1865, during the Original Public Land Survey, a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1919 Mr. Curo, Cass County Surveyor, subdivided Section 6 and set a 2" iron pipe at this corner.

In 1981 the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered a 2" iron pipe at this corner and set a 3/4" iron pin over the iron pipe.
