

Statement of Evidence:

- 1917 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner.
- 1981 U.S. Forest Service technician W. Olson found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts were set 4.0' north and 4.1' south of the corner. Line was run from the CW 1/16 corner of Section 30 south through this corner to the SW 1/16 corner of Section 30. Monument fit good with line and rough distance measurements also checked good with the 1917 GLO resurvey record.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 On Sept. 9 I visited the corner and found items as per the 1981 USFS reports. The U.S. Forest Service information indicates that the monument was found in the same position as when set in 1917.
