

Statement of Evidence:

- 1917 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 4" R. Oak N 20 E 13 links and 12" R. Oak S 6½ W 194 links.
- 1981 U.S. Forest Service technician W. Olson found the corner monument with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 0.3'. The following bearing trees were found: 23" R. Oak, dead and down, S 6 W 128'. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 On Sept. 9 I visited the corner and found items as per the 1981 USFS reports. The R. Oak log was cut open. Center was rotted and no scribe marks were found but old blaze scar was found facing corner. Believe this to be the 1917 bearing tree. Also badly rotted remains of 12" Oak stump found at N 20 E 8.5' level with the ground. Accepted monument as marking same position as when set in 1917 based on bearing tree evidence.
