
Northeast Corner of Section 20, Township 139N, Range 30W, 5th P.M.

Statement of Evidence:

Northeast Corner Section 20, Township 139 North, Range 30 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

The Original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1908, Mr. John Curo set an 8" x 8" concrete post for the corner from original bearing trees.

In 1967, Mr. Robert Schneider set a 3/4" drill rod for the corner.

In 1981, the Minnesota Department of Transportation excavated and recovered the 8" x 8" concrete post set by Curo and accepts this as the perpetuation of the original Government corner.
