

Statement of Evidence:

In 1919, Albinus N. Kimmel, a cadastral engineer set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for the S 1/16 corner from which he marked the following bt's, a 7" jack pine N 46-1/4 W 54 links and a 6" jack pine N 52-1/4 E 12 links.

On 12-23-1983, Walter E. Curo, a registered land surveyor and Ken Metcalf found the 1" pipe with brass cap as the corner falls in a cleared power line, we find no trace of the original bt's. We mark new bt's as shown on the front.
