

Statement of Evidence:

IN 1924, EARL G. HARRINGTON, A U.S. CADASTRAL ENGINEER SET A 1" x 36" IRON PIPE WITH BRASS CAP FOR A SPECIAL MC ON THE EAST-WEST CENTER LINE OF SECTION 12, FROM WHICH HE MARKED THE FOLLOWING BEARING TREE: A POPLAR 8" SOUTH 58 DEGREES 45 MINUTES WEST 115 LKS AND A MOUND OF STONE WEST OF CORNER.

ON 8-8-83, WALTER E. CURO, KEN METCALF, AND GREG CURO FOUND THE 1" IRON PIPE WITH BRASS CAP STANDING IN GOOD CONDITION, WE FIND NO TRACE OF THE POPLAR, THE MOUND OF STONE, TO THE WEST, IS STILL IN PLACE. WE MARK NEW BEARING TREES AS SHOWN ON FRONT.
