

# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER


South Quarter Corner of Section 17, Township 133, Range 31, 5th P.M.

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE FOR: South quarter corner, Section 17,  
Township 133 North, Range 31 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1863, the original Government Survey was performed and a wood post was set to mark this corner location.

In 1915 E. B. Horst ran this line but notes no corner found.

In 1984 and 1985 Landecker & Associates, Inc. while surveying in Section 16 and 17, said Township, found no evidence of said corner and established this corner in its lost position single proportionate between the Southwest and Southeast corners, said Section 17.

This location closely fits the topographic calls of the river as noted in the original government survey done in 1863.

Landecker & Associates, Inc. accepts this monument as the perpetuation of the original Government corner.
