


# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

East quarter corner, Section 21, Township 136 North, Range 31 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

The original Government survey was done in 1870, a post was set establishing the corner thereof.

1913 - John Curo sets 2½" iron pipe in concrete proportionately, see notes and plat in County survey record Book B, page 12 - 28.

1986 - David Landecker, RLS #17008, Landecker & Associates, Inc. finds the Southeast corner of Section 21 and establishes the Northeast corner of Section 21 from 1913 Curo survey records and then sets the East corner thereof proportionately as done by Curo and therefore accepts this monument as a perpetuation of said East Quarter corner.
