

Statement of Evidence: South One-Sixteenth Corner Eastline Section 1, T.141 N., R.28 W.,
5th P.M.

- 1918 US General Land Office dependent resurvey set a 1"x36" I.P. with marked brass cap and marked the following bearing trees:
10" N.Pine N 53½°E 443 lks., 10" N.Pine N 31½°W 538 lks.
- 1919 County Survey Record Book "C", page 347, shows a survey by E.B.Horst. He found the US I.M.
- 1972 US Forest Service personnel found brass cap monument and marked the following bearings: 15" N.Pine S 62°E 120.1', 12" N.Pine S 38°W 90.8', 15" N.Pine S 86°W 93.0', all scribed. 4"x4"x72" Cedar Post WEST 19.8'. William Okerman filed CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER.
- 1987 Walt Curo, under Forest Service contract, found GLO brass cap monument down 10" in centerline N-S road and all 3 1972 BT's. He files this certificate to update the 1972 certificate.
