

Statement of Evidence:

L-13

East Quarter Corner, Section 16, Township 140 North, Range 29 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1870 the original government survey was done by Orville Smith. A wood post was set to make the corner.

Two bearing trees witnessing said corners were marked, noted as follows:

9" basswood North 80 degrees East, 65 links  
10" basswood North 34 degrees West, 44 links

In 1919 E. B. Horst set 2" x 48" iron monuments, noted in County Book 'D', Page 35, and County Resurvey 'E-24'.

In 1926 John Greene finds iron monument noted in County Resurvey 'E-25'.

In 1978 Roger Mustonen, RLS #11946 while employed by W. J. Spain, Jr. RLS #2003 find capped iron pipe monument and uses in plat of SUNRISE TRAIL of record.

In 1987 David S. Landecker, RLS #17008, surveyor with the firm of Landecker & Associates, Inc. finds and accepts monument as used by Mustonen and Spain in 1978 as noted above.
