

Statement of Evidence:

North Quarter corner of Section 15

1-9-1874 P.H. Conger, Deputy Surveyor set a post for corner and witnessed as follows:

Poplar 4" South 47 links (31.02 feet)

Poplar 4" North 25 degrees West 36 links (23.76 feet)

Said records are filed with the Secretary of State, St. Paul, MN.

11-5-1968 C. Krause, USFS, chained West from section corner, position fell East of fence line to North found no evidence of monument using dip needle. Said records are on file with the USFS in Cass Lake, MN.

10-20-1987 Personnel of Kovanen Surveying found 8" spike 1 foot below road surface, 3 feet North of centerline, on the extension Southerly of a fence to the North. Also found a FSLP and post (leans North) North 19.22 feet, tag rusty and reads "South 0.28 chs to 1/4 cor" no date or initials. Rob Main, USFS, estimated this tag to be circa 1930, CCC.

1-19-1988 Personnel of Kovanen Surveying set corner from the evidence found on 10-20-87 and monument and witness said position as shown on the sketch.

An analysis of the above data indicates that this is not a perpetuation of the original GLO corner, but it is accepted as the corner for lack of evidence to the contrary.
