

Statement of Evidence: Center West one-sixteenth Corner, Section 9, T.141 N., R.29 W.,  
5th P.M.

- 1918 US General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner by setting a 1" x 36" I.P. with marked brass cap in trail. The following bearing trees were marked: 9" W. Oak N 8°30'E 61 lks., 7" W. Oak S 5°30'W 42 lks.
- 1987 On Sept. 2, a MN Dept. of Natural Resources survey crew found the Glo brass cap monument flush with the ground in the center of an old trail. No sign of the GLO BT's. The corner position checks with other corners in the area. Marked new BT's
- 1987 On Sept. 8, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician, visited the corner with the same DNR survey crew. Placed a 7' steel sign post with "Survey Marker" sign EAST 5.0' The DNR trees were scribed and "BT" tags put on them.
