

R-17,18 MC Sections 23 & 26 (West Side)

- 1874 P.H. Conger set post for corner and the following references:
N. Pine 18" bears N 78 degrees E, 96 Links (63.36 feet)
Fir 6" bears S 49 degrees W, 45 Links (29.70 feet)
- 1918 Dependent resurvey by GLO, notes state unable to find evidence of original post or bearing trees, established new MC and the following references:
Poplar 10" bears N 71 1/4 degrees E, 113 Links (74.58 feet)
W. Pine 12" bears S 43 1/4 degrees W, 227 Links (149.82 feet)
- 1965 John Stark RLS, surveyed Plat of "Likens North Shore Beach". Plat indicates GLO (1918) monument in place. Bearing trees not mentioned.
- 12-13-88 Personnel from Kovanen & Osufsen Surveyors find 1918 GLO corner. Left monument as found and add new witnesses as shown on Certificate.
- This position is not a perpetuation of the original GLO corner, but accepted as corner for lack of further evidence.
