

Northeast Corner, Section 8, T.133N., R.31W., 5th P.M.

- 1863 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: a 5" Ash N63E 27 links, a 14" Aspen S7 3/4 E 27 links, a 15" Aspen S60 3/4 W 54 links, and a 5" Ash N38 3/4 W 43 links.
- 1915 County Survey Record Book "B", pages 490-495, show a survey by N.D. Gorman. He began at the corner and ran west.
- 1985 On October 29, Cass County Survey Technician Terry Freeman talked with Don Corner a resident in Section 5. He said that the stone that was set for the corner was bladed out years ago when County Road 102 was rebuilt.
- 1986 On October 15, Terry Freeman placed a cast iron monument in centerlines of the north to south road and the east to west road down 6".
