1/4 Cor. 11 and 14 (N 1/4 Cor. Sec. 14)

- 1872 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for corner and the following references were noted:
Poplar 6" S 8 degrees E, 75 Links (49.50 feet)
Spruce 2" N 69 degrees E, 60 Links (39.60 feet)
- 1969 Curt Krause, USFS, chained to search area from section corner to west, area has been heavily burned, no large trees remain, mostly brush and small aspen, no evidence of corner, or BT's found.
- 11-8-1989 Personnel from Kovanen & Osufsen Inc. search area is near corner of clearcut, no evidence of corner found.
- 5-10-1990 Personnel from Kovanen & Osufsen Inc. made an additional search of area and set a 2" x 54" brass capped monument on an 8' steel fence post in wet area, in lost position on line between adjacent reestablished section corners and the following witnesses:
Balm of Gilead 8" S 04 degrees E, 66.17 feet
Aspen 6" N 27 degrees W, 71.05 feet
Aspen 11" West, 131.80 feet
Set 8' steel sign post with sign attached, East 3.3 feet
Set 8' steel sign post with sign attached, North 4.8 feet

This position is not traceable to the original GLO corner, but accepted as corner for lack of further evidence.
