

Statement of Evidence:

Reference Monument on North Line of Section 35,
Township 139 North, Range 26 West, Lawrence Lake

In 1863 the Original Public Land Survey was run and a wood post was set at the meander corner on the westside of Lawrence Lake, 910.14 feet east of the Northwest Corner of Section 35 which falls in Lawrence Lake. Distance was measured on the ice.

In 1946 plat "Part of Lot 7-S26-T139N-R26W" by Gus Holstrom calls for an iron pipe on the north line of Section 35 at the Southeast Corner of Lot 1.

In 1950 plat "Luschers Bay" by Gus Holstrom shows a monument on the north line of Section 35, near Lawrence Lake, and a monument at M.C. #30, 383.2 feet east of said Southeast Corner of Lot 1.

In 1951 Mn/DOT location notes call for an iron pipe at said Southeast Corner of Lot 1.

In 1969 Mr. Don Coulter surveyed Government Lots 1 and 2 in Section 35 and indicates he found a monument at said Southeast Corner of Lot 1 and set a capped pipe, stamped 26/35, 366.45 feet east of said Southeast Corner of Lot 1.

In 1991 Mn/DOT recovered Mr. Coulter's capped pipe and the pipe at the said Southeast Corner of Lot 1.

Mr. Coulter's pipe is on the north line of Section 25, 16.75 feet west of the pipe shown as M.C. #30 on the plat of "Luschers Bay." Mn/DOT accepts Mr. Coulter's pipe as a Reference Monument on the north line of Section 35.
