



1874 P.H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, originally established this corner position while subdividing Township 141 North, Range 27 West. The notes indicate that he set a wood post and marked the following bearing trees: a 15 inch Cedar North 89 degrees East a distance of 10 links (6.60 feet); and a 10 inch Cedar South 85 degrees West a distance of 8 links (5.28 feet).

1980 Bert Eveland, Registered Land Surveyor for the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, filed a "Certificate of Location of Government Corner", Cass County Document Number 258661. The certificate indicates that he found a 1 inch iron pipe up 1.4 feet next to an old 3 inch square wood post up 3 feet. He marked one bearing tree: a 12 inch Cedar stump North 80 degrees East a distance of 148 feet.

1993 on December 13, a Landecker & Associates, Inc. survey crew found an iron pipe monument in place. They pulled the found monument and set two 5 foot sections of aluminum rod with a 3 foot stabilizer topped with an aluminum cap. They also found the 1980 Minnesota Department of Natural Resources Cedar stump East 148 feet. New bearing trees were marked and a steel sign post set as noted on front of this certificate.

Landecker & Associates, Inc. accepts the monument as a perpetuation of the corner accepted by the Department of Natural Resources in 1980.
