

Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner of Section 14, Township 133, Range 31 West, 5th Principle Meridian, Cass County Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1863 and a post was set to mark the corner. Bearing ties were made to two Oak trees.

In 1912, Mr. John Curo recovered two stumps of the original bearing ties and set a stake to mark the corner. Bearing ties were made to an Oak and a Poplar stump.

In May of 1986, Freeman excavated at a lost location and set a 2" by 18" telespar monument on 10/28/86. Bearing ties were made to a power pole, and two reference monuments.

A Jan. 22, 1990 Certificate of Survey filed by Walter Curo, RLS 11395, indicates evidence of Freeman's 1986 information.

In 2006 Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a telespar monument. Bearing tree ties were made to a 6" white pine, a power pole, and a reference monument. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
