

Statement of Evidence: Northeast corner Section 22, Township 133 North, Range 31 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1863 and a wood post was set to mark the corner. Bearing tree ties were made to four aspen trees.

In 1921, E.B. Horst set a 2" by 48" iron pipe monument.

In 1985, Mr. David Landecker recovered a 2" iron pipe monument with an aluminum stamped cap. Bearing tree ties were made to three white oaks, a burr oak, and a twin oak.

In 1985, Mr. David Landecker shows the pipe on a certificate.

In 2006 Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a telspar monument with an aluminum stamped cap. Bearing tree ties to three white oaks were recovered. An additional bearing tree tie was made to a corner fence post. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
