
North Quarter Corner of Section 1, Township 133, Range 32

**Statement of Evidence:** North Quarter Corner of Section 1, Township 133, Range 32 West, 5<sup>th</sup> Principle Meridian, Cass County Minnesota.

The Original Government Survey was run in 1858 and a post was set to mark the corner. Bearing ties were made to two Spruce trees.

In 2004, Mr. Bruce Grivna indicates monument found by Certificate of Survey as evidenced by Cass County Surveyor records.

On June 20, 2006, Kramer Leas DeLeo recovered a Telspar monument. Two existing bearing trees were recovered and a bearing tree tie was made to an aspen. Kramer Leas DeLeo accepts this as the correct location for the corner.
