

1863 The US General Land Office field notes, on file in the Secretary of State's Office, indicate a post set at the corner with the following bearing trees:

6" Tamarack	N 8° W	13 Links (8.58')
4" Tamarack	S 25° E	25 Links (16.5')

1936 Civilian Conservation Corps field notes Book 7, page 21, located at the Washburn Lake DNR Forestry office show a survey for the north line of Section 4. An old square stake was found at both northwest and northeast corners and a distance of 79.90 chains was measured between them. They did not find anything for this corner, nor did they mention if they performed a search for this corner.

2008 In October, the DNR survey crew searched and found no evidence of the corner or accessories. The corner was determined lost and established by the single proportion method between the Northeast corner of Section 5 and the Northeast corner of Section 4. A 1"x 60" inside diameter iron pipe with plastic cap stamped "MN DNR LS 44974" was set and ties were taken.

 Northeast corner of Section 4 bears S 89°48'36" E 2625.95'
