







That I reside at Bemidji, Minnesota, and am registered as a Land Surveyor under the laws of the State of Minnesota, having Surveyor's Registration Certificate No. 6807.

I further depose and say that on the 10th day of September, 1969, I found the Section corner of Sections 9-10-15-16 which was evidenced by remains of the original Government survey of 1872 and G.L.O. resurvey of 1922.
