



STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

The North Quarter Corner of Section 8, Township 139 North, Range 31 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

This corner was originally a wood post set by the Government Land Office in 1870.

In October 1908, Mr. John Curo, Cass County Surveyor, found evidence of the two original bearing trees and set a 4"x4"x48" post. (Book A of Surveys page 314)

In August 2009 Cass County Survey Technician Bryan Hippen found a 10d nail location based on the Curo 1911 data. Old stumps were found at GLO bearing and distance from the location. He placed railroad spikes in the stumps, located these with GPS and took photos.

In September 2009, a survey crew from Ulteig Engineers found evidence of the bearing trees. A rebar with plastic cap marked "MN LS 40035" was set using the original bearing trees. Curo's distance to the west corroborates this position.
