

Statement of Evidence

Northeast corner Section 8, Township 133 North, Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

June 1863 T.Walker and W.Smith, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyors set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:
14" Aspen S 7°30' E 27 links (17.8 feet) 5" Ash N 63° E 27 links (17.8 feet)
15" Aspen S 60°45' W 54 links (35.6 feet) 5" Ash N 38°45' W 43 links (28.4 feet)
Said records are on file with the Secretary of State, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).

July 1915 N.D. Gorman, Engineer, Survey Record No.335, Book B, page 493, on file in the CCSO, states "Begin at cor to secs 4, 5, 8, 9, T 133, R 31, running West".

Oct. 1985 T. Freeman, technician, CCSO, Land Corner Record, on file in the CCSO, states talked with Don Corner a resident in Section 5. He said that the stone that was set for the corner was bladed out years ago when County Road 102 was rebuilt.

Oct. 1986 T. Freeman, technician, CCSO, Land Corner Record, on file in the CCSO, indicates a cast iron monument set at centerline of County Road Number 102 and centerline of East to West road, down 6". Witnessed as follows:
6" B. Oak S 70° W 81.65 feet P. Pole N 53° W 39.00 feet
18" B. Oak N 50° E 77.25 feet Survey Marker Sign S 45° E 50.0 feet

Jan. 1990 W. Curo, LS 11395, Cass County Surveyor, filed a Certificate of Location of Government Corner, on file in the Cass County Recorders Office and the CCSO, pertaining to the 1986 data, as Document Number 318248.

June 2001 B.Hippen and C. Loe, technicians, CCSO, notes on file in the CCSO, found a CIM, 0.4' below road surface, 1 foot +/- East of centerline of County Road Number 102, on centerline of 124th Street.

July 2013 B.Hippen, technician, CCSO, records of the CCSO, found monument and witnesses from 2001. The monument, recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by CCSO in 2001 is the accepted location of this corner.
