

Statement of Evidence

Northeast corner of Section 6, Township 139 North, Range 25 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

Nov.20 G. Johnson and A. Thornton, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyors, in the survey of the north line
1863 of this township, set a post in a marsh for the original corner with bearing tree as follow:
8" Y. Pine N 40° W 63 links (41.58 feet) 10" Y. Pine N 18° E 504 links (332.64 feet)
8" Y. Pine S 3 1/2° E 600 links (396.00 feet) 10" Y. Pine S 67° W 81 links (53.46 feet)
The original plat and above record are archived with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota,
copies are filed with Cass County.

Jan.13 E.B. Horst, Deputy County Surveyor, Curo Field Book 68, on file with Cass County. Page 17 states "...go S
1916 one mile to Twp line of 140-25 and 139-25 – Sections 31-32 and Sec 5-6 where U.S. notes call for...Cor
supposed to be in West side of small swamp country all burned over and no B.T.s can be found".
Information on file in Cass County Highway Department/Surveyor's Office.

1937 Civilian Conservation Corps, Washburn Lake Book 1, page 14, on file with the Minnesota Department of
Natural Resources in Brainerd, MN. The Cass County Land Corner Record states "Set APP. Post 80 CH.
from west". Information on file in Cass County Highway Department/Surveyor's Office.

Nov. Northwestern Surveying and Engineering, Inc. (NWSE), crew of Bomstad and Walker-O'Beirne searched
2013 for the subject corner with no recovery.

March NWSE, Robert Kovanen, LS 16459, reviewed existing information and determined the corner lost. A
2014 position was computed at single proportion between the recovered and certified Northwest corner of Section
6 and Northeast corner of Section 5. The search position falls near an island in a flooded area.

April NWSE, crew of Bomstad and Walker-O'Beirne made an additional search for the subject corner and found
2014 the search position falls just off the east edge of an island that appears to be used by duck hunters. The
GLO witnesses were searched for and remains were found that fit the lost position well, although not
conclusive. A ½ by 36 inch rebar, capped LS 16459 was placed at the lost position described above. The
monument, together with the recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face
of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument
established by NWSE in 2014 is the accepted location of this corner.
