

Statement of Evidence:

Meander Corner on East Line of Section 4,
Township 138 North, Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian.
Corner is south of the Northeast Corner of Section 4.

In 1865, during the Original Public Land Survey, wood posts were set south, east and west of the Northwest Corner of Section 3.

In 1915 Mr. Curo, Cass County Surveyor, set a 2-1/2" capped pipe at the three (3) Meander Corner locations. Notes indicate that at the West Meander Corner he found the original post. The South and East Corners are unclear.

In 1940 the CCC (Civilian Conservation Corps) found capped iron pipes at all three locations.

In 1981 the Minnesota Department of Transportation found the capped pipes in place south and east. The west pipe was found lying in the lake.
