

Statement of Evidence:

- 1919 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 4" Birch S 79 3/4 E 33 links and 14" R. Oak S 87 3/4 W 234 links.
- 1979 U.S. Forest Service technician C. Krause found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 8". The following bearing trees were found: 11" Birch S 80 E 21.8' with overgrown scar and badly rotted Oak stump and Log S 88 W 154.4'. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. A steel sign post was set 2.5' east of the corner.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1919 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
