

Statement of Evidence:

- 1873 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 6" Tamarack N 14 E 16 links, 4" Cedar S 11 E 17 links, 10" Cedar N 12 W 9 links, and 4" Cedar S 30 W 15 links.
- 1937 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey reestablished this corner by proportionate distance. There was no evidence found of the original corner or bearing trees. An iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 7" Poplar S 84 E 281 links.
- 1980 U.S. Forest Service technician R. Olesen found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument set in a concrete cylinder 6" below swamp surface. The following bearing trees were found: Remains of rotted stump S 84 E 185.5'. One new bearing tree was marked and is shown on this certificate. No other trees close for ties. Set four steel sign posts as witness for corner as shown on this certificate.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1937 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
