



In 1917, Earl G. Harrington, US Surveyor, set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for the MC on the north line of Sec. 1 from which he made the following BT's. A 12" tamarac N 33 W 553 LKS and a 8" birch S 2½ W 427 LKS.

On September 24, 1981, Walter E. Curo, and Paul Johnson find the brass cap leaning over in bog. We stand it up straight and drive a 8" steel fence post along side and wire corner to it. We don't find the original BT's. We make new BT's on the only trees available as shown on front.
