

**Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner, Section 8, Township 139 North,
Range 30 West, 5th Principal Meridian.**

The original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1907, Mr. John Curo set an 8" x 8" concrete post for the corner from the original southeast bearing tree.

In 1975, Mr. Walt Curo set a cast iron monument for the corner from record distances. Certificate of Location filed in County Recorders Office in Walker.

In 1981, the Minnesota Department of Transportation excavated and recovered the 8" x 8" concrete post, down 0.5', and accepts this as the perpetuation of the original Government Corner.
