

Statement of Evidence:

The North Quarter Corner of Section 17, Township 133, Range 30, 5th Principal Meridian, Cass County, Minnesota was set under the Public Land Survey as a post with two bearing trees by William P. Allen in Nov. 1870. No traces of post or bearing trees now exist.

In 1950, the Cass County Highway Department noted an 1" iron monument at the N $\frac{1}{4}$ position.

The 1" Iron Pin is accepted as the monument noted by the Cass County Highway Dept. in 1950 and also is accepted as the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 17-133-30. A Cass County Cast Iron Monument was placed over the found 1" Iron Pin. Refer to Comstock & Davis file No. LF84014, Book 10, Page 22. Comstock & Davis, Inc. found a 1" iron pin at the North Quarter Corner position on June 5, 1984.
