

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE FOR: North quarter corner, Section 16, Township
133 North, Range 31 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1863, the original Government Survey was performed and a wood post was set to mark this corner location.

In 1915 E. B. Horst set a wood post at single proportionate distance between the Northeast and Northwest corners of said Section 16.*

In 1984 Landecker & Associates, Inc. set a monument at the lost position for this corner single proportionate as done in 1915 by E. B. Horst and accepts this monument to be a perpetuation of the original Government corner.
