


CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

East quarter corner, Section 10, Township 139 North, Range 29 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

The original government survey was done in 1865, a post was set establishing the corner thereof.

1910 - A. W. Moulster finds old stake and original government Northwest bearing tree. County survey record Book B, page 159.

1912 - John Curo finds original government bearing tree stump Northwest and sets a wood stake, County survey book B, page 200 - 211.

1975 - Myron Landecker, RLS #7452, Landecker & Associates, Inc. finds corner and shows on Plat of Ponto Lake Cemetery First Addition.

1986 - David Landecker, RLS #17008, Landecker & Associates, Inc. find railroad spike, a corner position which fits both the 1912 Curo survey and 1975 survey by Myron Landecker and therefore Landecker & Associates, Inc. accepts this corner as a perpetuation of the East quarter corner of said Section 10.
