



STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

W.C. for MC #31, Section 11, Township 139 North, Range 30 West, 5th P.M., Cass County, Minneosta.

- 1865 - U. S. General Land Office set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees:  
5" tamarak South 48 degrees East 53 lks, 14" birch North 78 degrees East 93 lks.
- 1925 - J. M. Greene finds iron monument in place on North line of Section 11 for the W.C. and M.C. during subdivision and platting work within said section. Notes in Book 190, Page 3 & 4 (Curo's records).
- 1971 - W. J. Spain surveys plat of Bresson's Four Point lodge using different location for North line as found and used in Greene survey.
- 1987 - Landecker & Associates, Inc. surveyors, while surveying in said Section 11 find several irons established in Greene survey of 1925 and accept Greene's position for the North line of said Section 11 and have monumented the W.C. and M.C. the same as Greene.
