



Statement of Evidence:

South Quarter corner, Section 11, Township 139 North, Range 30 West,
5th P.M., Cass County, Minnesota.

- 1865 - U. S. General Land Office set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees:
10" norway pine North 50 degrees West 123 lks.
- 1915 - Gorman found U. S. BT and 6" x 6" x 60" post and reset a 2½" x 48" iron monument, County Book "D", Page 41 and 45.
- 1915 - J. Curo in a County resurvey of Section 14, said township, finds Gormans monument and makes new ties, County Resurvey Plat ("E"-34).
- 1925 - J. M. Greene shows iron monument in place in notes found in Book 190, Page 3 & 4 (Curo's notes) while surveying in said Section 11.
- 1987 - Landecker & Associates, Inc., surveyors, find and accept the monument set by Gorman and used by Curo and Greene previously.
