

**Statement of Evidence:** Southeast Corner Section 34, T.141 N., R. 30 W., 5th P.M.  
(Standard Corner to Sections 34 & 35).

- 1863 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 8" Spruce N 40°W 8 lks., 7" Spruce N 74°E 13 lks.
- 1965 William Okerman, USFS Surveyor, found a 1½" I.P. at corner location. He marked two new bearings: 4" Tamarack N 41°W 109.0', 6" Birch N 58°E 48.2'. He filed an AFFIDAVIT AS TO LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER. A 2"x60" I.P. was set.
- 1987 On March 31, Terry Freeman, Survey Technician and Larry Olson, Forester found the 2" I.P. up 3'. Tamarack NW is dead and Birch NE is down. Marked two new B.T.'s: 5" Burr Oak N 78°E 45.52', 9" Burr Oak S 55°E 88.98'.
