

Statement of Evidence: Northeast Corner Section 4, T.134 N., R.31 W., 5th P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 12" Spruce S 53°E 50 lks., 5" Spruce N 81°E 7½ lks., 6" Spruce N 17°W 69 lks., 8" Spruce S 16°W 157 lks.
- 1985 On Oct. 31, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician found a ½" x 18" I.P. at P.I. of roads N-S-E-W, down 0.2'.
- 1986 On Oct. 7, Terry Freeman, Jim Cripps and Norman Maunu pulled ½" I.P. and replaced with cast iron monument down 6". Marked the bearings as shown on front of this certificate.
